SkyWest Inc. Names Eric Woodward New Vice President -Controller

St. George, February 22, 2007 - SkyWest, Inc., (NASDAQ: SKYW) the holding company for SkyWest Airlines and Atlantic Southeast Airlines, announced Eric Woodward will assume responsibilities as Vice President - Controller of SkyWest, Inc. and its subsidiaries. In his new position, Woodward will be responsible for financial planning, accounting, SEC reporting, internal controls and managing various contract issues with SkyWest's major partners, Delta Air Lines, United Airlines and Midwest Airlines. Woodward joined SkyWest as director of financial planning and analysis in April 2004. Additionally, he was responsible for models and calculations for departure rates with SkyWest's partner carriers.

"Eric's strong background in profit planning and forecasting have already proved invaluable," said Brad Rich, SkyWest, Inc., Executive Vice President and Chief Financial Officer. "His extensive understanding in the financial industry and his experience at SkyWest these last few years will help posture us for continued future growth."

Woodward has an impressive background in the financial industry and public accounting. He spent seven years servicing companies in the transportation, manufacturing and distribution, hospitality and software industries. He has a master's degree in Accounting from the University of Utah and is a member of the American Institute of Certified Public Accountants and the Utah Association of Certified Public Accountants.

Eric and his wife, Annie live in St. George, Utah with their four children.

SkyWest Airlines, based in St. George, Utah, and Atlantic Southeast Airlines (ASA), based in Atlanta, Georgia are wholly owned subsidiaries of SkyWest, Inc. SkyWest Airlines operates as United Express and Delta Connection carriers under contractual agreements with United Airlines and Delta Air Lines. In December 2006, SkyWest Airlines signed a third agreement with Midwest Airlines, and operations begin in April 2007. ASA operates as a Delta Connection carrier under a contractual agreement with Delta Air Lines. System-wide, SkyWest, Inc. serves a total of approximately 233 cities in the United States, Canada, Mexico and the Caribbean, with approximately 2,520 daily departures.
